Tot Football is a great way to teach preschoolers, not only the basic skills needed in football - it is a great way to work on their



listening skills, cooperation and sportsmanship. Because of their age and the inherent roughness of football, this is a skills class, with no actual games being played.

Day and Times: Saturdays, 12pm - 1pm

Stances / Form Tackling
Passing / Receiving

Following directions

In **Tot Soccer** students will begin with 20 minutes of drills and foot skills, learn how to line up on the field, where in and out of bounds are and play actual soccer games. Age appropriate safety equipment is used and basic ground rules are set for the children and parents so that everyone enjoys their time while participating. Size 3 soccer balls will be used in class.
